## Std 1 to 5

- No terminal and annual exams are conducted for students till Std 5.

  We periodically evaluate the students in all subjects in Std 1 to 5. We don't inform the students or parents regarding evaluation date so we can come to know about their actual knowledge of a particular topic.
- ✓ We evaluate the skills such as creative writing, comprehension and listening. Textual questions and grammar and questions from selected chapters will be asked as well.
- ✓ The grades in the report card will be based on periodic evaluation, participation in class and activities, presence in class and observation.

## o Std. 6 to 8

✓ Students in Std 6 to 8 shall have Evaluation pattern as per CBSE norms. They will have one terminal and one annual exam and periodic tests. Usually students are informed of tests in advance. Sometimes surprise periodic test is also conducted.
